



# AFRICAN RESTORATION

## STRATEGIC PLAN

### 1.0 THE PAST

Tens of billions of dollars have been spent in recent years in the name of improving conditions in Africa. Malaria and Aids were to have been rolled back, but both of these deadly diseases have greatly increased. So far, only large corporations and politicians seem to have prospered.

It is time that corruption and greed be bypassed and creative, efficient solutions be brought forward. It is time for goodness to drive out evil. It is time that the last become first!

### 2.0 PRESENT: "Bring the Cure for Malaria to Africa."

#### 2.1 Import Herbs from China: Bring immediate results.

Chinese Wormwood can be imported to Africa; each pound would be sufficient to heal one person of Malaria. Carefully administered, this cure will cost \$1 per person treated. This is the fastest, least expensive way to bring effective healing to the desperately sick.

#### 2.2 Economic Development: Establish herbal farms.

Select farm sites in various regions of Africa, and establish irrigation systems that insure against crop failure. Within 3 years these farms can be self sufficient, producing abundant supply at a price equal to imports. Create a sustainable supply, giving two-thirds of their production to the poor and selling the other third at a price sufficient to pay all operating expenses and maintenance.

#### 2.3 Distribute Herbal Remedy: Faith based organizations distribute herbs free to the poor.

The herbal remedy is to be distributed to the poor free of charge by NGO type, faith based organizations in order to bypass most of the influence of the following inhibiting factors:

- **Greed:** The treatment of Malaria has become a multi-billion dollar industry. A simple, low cost cure is contrary to the interests of big medical businesses.
- **Corruption:** "... officials skim from the treasury, tons of food imported from relief organizations disappear, an average Kenyan pays 16 bribes per month..." It has been estimated that 41% of the cost of goods is due to corruption.
- **Traditions of Medical Community:** Under the guise of protecting the public, the medical community makes enormous profits from the misfortune of sick people, while systematically eliminating alternatives

#### 2.4 Ministry Alliance: Coordinate faith based organizations.

Faith based organizations are to coordinate their restoration efforts through a separately funded central alliance for the effective benefit to the most people.

### **3.0 THE FUTURE**

Bringing the cure for Malaria to all of Africa is only the first step. African Restoration plans:

- **To bring a similar herbal cure for the River Disease of the Black Fly and an effective herbal treatment for HIV**
- **To empower the people through Socio-Economic Development, and forging business alliances between Africa, China, India and Israel**
- **To coordinate ministry which offers to change the face of all Africa**
